

SIU Senior Management

The SIU Senior Manager will be responsible for managing SIU contract client as embedded SIU Director at client location in the Los Angeles, CA area. The SIU Division encompasses complex claims investigations, suspicious and fraudulent claims investigations, coordination with law enforcement or state fraud bureaus for regulatory compliance and criminal prosecutions. The position also conducts training sessions for adjusters, supervisors and other staff on anti-fraud and claim related topics. The Senior SIU Manager will regularly visit SIU client claims offices and provide assistance on suspect claims.

- Expert investigative consulting on corporate fraud and corporate investigations within assigned territory;

- Technical direction to investigators on complex and SIU investigations;
